

PUBLIC CLEANLINESS AND HEALTH



☐ To article 14 concerning the cleanliness of public spaces and torn bin bags on the public road.
On, our Peace officers observed a breach of the General Police Regulations :
Concerns : property located atN°
Dear Sir or Madam,

- §1. It is forbidden to soil or damage any object or place in the public space in any way whatsoever, whether caused by oneself or by persons, animals or things in one's care or control, such as:
 - 1. Any object used for public utility or decoration;
 - 2. Any item of street furniture;
 - 3. Galleries and passageways on private land accessible to the public;
 - 4. Public buildings and private property, including facades, low walls, railings and other construction elements bordering the public space.
- §2. This includes abandoning or throwing away cigarette butts, cans, plastic or glass bottles, any kind of paper, food waste, etc. It is forbidden to empty ashtrays anywhere in the public space.
- ☐ To article 28 concerning the disposal of waste and the depositing of household waste and selective collections outside authorised days and times.
 - §1. Household waste and objects or materials intended for selective collections organised by the Region must be presented for collection in accordance with the instructions of the Agence Bruxelles-Propreté or any approved body (timetable, location, type of container, etc.).
 - §3. If the waste collection service has not collected the waste at the scheduled time, it is the responsibility of everyone to bring in their rubbish and/or to prove that they have contacted the municipal or regional waste collection service within 24 hours to report the problem.
- ☐ In accordance with Article 1 of the Municipal Regulations on the collection of household waste concerning the use of rigid bins.
 - The official white bags must be placed in a rigid bin without a lid, which must not obstruct passage.

We would ask you to intervene as soon as possible or face a fine of up to 500 EUR, and thank you for your cooperation.
