•	§2. The purpose of this obligation is to keep walkways, pavements and roads good condition, and to ensure pedestrian safety by, among other things, remslippery materials and/or products and controlling vegetation in accordance with and article 48 of these regulations. Keeping pavements and roadsides in gomeans removing fallen leaves and sweeping and maintaining snow-covered or	noving dirty and/or regional legislation ood condition also

accordance with current legislation, to prevent them from slipping.

- §1. Pavements covered with fallen leaves, snow or ice must be swept or rendered non-slippery in their entirety or over two-thirds of their width, with a minimum of 1.50 m depending on the width of the pavement, in order to facilitate safe passage for pedestrians. Snow must be deposited on and at the edge of the pavement and must not be thrown onto the road.
 - Where this is not possible, the snow will be deposited on the edge of the road. Sewer gutters and pedestrian crossings must be kept clear.
- §2. The spreading of sand or any other product for the purpose of melting snow or frost on outside steps, pavements or the public highway does not relieve the persons carrying out the work of the obligations set out in this provision.

We would ask you to intervene as soon as possible or face a fine of up to 500 EUR, and thank you for your cooperation.
