

NOTICE PUBLIC SAFETY AND EASE OF PASSAGE



Dear Sir or Madam,

Concerns : property located at N°.....

On, our Peace officers observed a breach of the General Police Regulations :

To article 61 concerning private occupation of public space and objects that could cause harm if they fall.

- **§1.** Trees and plantations on private property must be trimmed so that any branch overhanging the public highway is at least 2.50 m above the ground and its end at least 0.50 m back from the carriageway. Trimming must be carried out in compliance with the specific provisions laid down for this purpose in current legislation concerning, in particular, nature conservation.
- **§2.** Under no circumstances, may trees or plantations mask the luminous flux of public lighting, nor obscure any object of public utility.
- **§3.** Hedges must not overhang the public road and must be trimmed at all times so as not to reduce the width of the public road.
- **§4.** If particular safety reasons so require, the authorised officer may impose different measures and the prescribed work must be carried out.
- **§5.** Any person who contravenes the provisions of this article is required to put things right immediately. Failing this, the competent authority reserves the right to take action at the offender's expense and risk.

We would ask you to intervene as soon as possible or face a fine of up to 500 EUR, and thank you for your cooperation.
